Dear Mrs

I have made my will in 1915
your favour before but I was afraid
to say so when I was home

I have arrived in France safe and sound and
am in to the fighting once more. I have seen the Priest
before I left Dublin. I hope you are quiet well and Mr
Byrne too. Did you get any word from James yet.
is Prince and the pup there yet. Let me tell you this
the morning before I left Dublin and had to alter my
allowance owing to this if you were in need I could leave
ninepence a day and the government would add some more
to it making it 12/6 per week but they would send an officer
round to see if you were in need so I said you were not
in need of it so under the rules I could only leave sixpence
which I have done. Let me no if you have received it yet
I have made my will in your favour so what money I
do not get you will get. I hope all the friends are all
well Goodbye God bless you.
