I leave to the Roman Catholic Bishop of Southwark the Balance of all pay due to me from the British Government.

Also any War Bonus or Gratuities that may be due to me from 20th December 1915.

As a Re-enlisted man, my pay should be $\frac{5}{6}$ per day. At present I am receiving $\frac{1}{3}$ per day.

13 (Thirteen) Months pay from September 1915. If I had

a Permanent Address this money would be paid

regularly on the 1st of each Month at the rate of

£8 (eight) per month. At the present time there is

£104 (one hundred & four) due to me. If I died in

South Africa. The Secretary of the above Board

would have to pay 14 (fourteen) Burial Expenses

It is my wish to leave the whole entirely to the

Roman Catholic Bishop of Southwark. The reason

I stopped payment was because I had no

address & was serving with the B.C.F. in France
