STATEMENT MADE BY NO. 19170 Pte. SAMUEL ROWE. 10th ROYAL INNISKILLING FUSILIERS.

"War Office letter dated 26th September, 1917 has been read te me regarding my Brether Ne. 19562 Private R.J. ROWE of 10th Battalien Reyal Inniskilling Fusiliers reported "MISSING" en the 1st JULY, 1916."

My answers to the queries therein mentioned are as fellews :-

- (1) August, 1915 at his ewn residence at Drimeclish. Tamlaghtecrilly. Upperlands, Co. Derry, Ireland.
- (2) In case anything happens to me I leave all I pessess te my Sister, Mrs Cellins, Drumeelish.
- (3) Mr. William Cellins, Drume elish, was present at the time and heard that statement made.
