STATEMENT MADE BY NO. 19170 Pte. SAMUEL ROWE.

10th ROYAL INNISKILLING FUSILIERS.

"War Office letter dated 26th September, 1917 has been read  
to me regarding my Brother No. 19562 Private R.J. ROWE of  
10th Battalion Royal Inniskilling Fusiliers reported "MISSING"  
on the 1st JULY, 1916."

My answers to the queries therein mentioned are as  
follows :-

(1) August, 1915 at his own residence at Drumeelish,  
Tamlaghtecrilly. Upperlands, Co. Derry, Ireland.

(2) In case anything happens to me I leave all I possess  
to my Sister, Mrs Collins, Drumeelish.

(3) Mr. Williams Collins, Drumeelish, was present at the  
time and heard that statement made.
