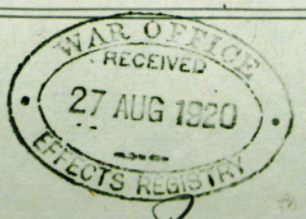

With reference to attached, I beg to state, that, as far as I can recollect, I received the letter referred to, from Mrs. Carroll some time in November, 1916, and I believe it was for the purpose of dictating and addressing her reply to deceased.

I have recollection that, deceased, stated in that letter that, should he not survive any effects or property he was possessed of would be given over by his authorities to her.

Mrs. Carroll is illiterate hence the reason for her bringing me the letter.
