STATEMENT of No. I4883 sergeant John KIRKPATRICK, 11th Battalion Royal Inniskilling Fusiliers, re Estate & Personal Effects of the late No. I4882 Lance Corporal Alexander KIRKPATRICK, 11th (S) Bn. Royal Inniskilling Fusiliers.

"My brother the late No. I4882 Lance Corporal Alexander KIRKPATRICK had made his will in his pay book (A.B. 64) which I saw about the 26th June, 1916, in this will he left all his property and personal effects to my sister, Mrs. Mary DUNLOP, 37 Queen Victoria Gardens, Belfast, IRELAND.

My brother the late No. I4882 Lance Corporal Alexander KIRKPATRICK "Missing" on the 1st July, 1916 and has since been reported "Believed Killed". His pay book (A.B. 64) was in his possession on the 1st July, 1916 and it has never been found."
