Statement by 75,290 Sergt. Morrell. W. R.F.A.

On the 26th, January 1916, at Bastin Street, Athlone. Ireland. my brother-in-law No. 6/4654 Pte, John Smith, Connaught Rangers showed me his Pay book showing his will, and in it was "In the event of my death, I leave all my belongings to my Mother, Mrs. Mary Ann Smith of Bastin St. Athlone. He said to me "If I am killed I will leave everything to Mother" My wife Elizabeth Morrell of 174 Drayton Park, London, can I believe give similar testimony.
