



(b) Insert the amount of money or the name of the article which it is wished to give. * If the soldier desires to mention only one person in his Will this part is to be left blank, if more than two persons, the names and legacies can be added. + If the Will is executed in Scotland by a Scotsman, the words "In the event, &c.," "and I give to" must be written by the man himself.
