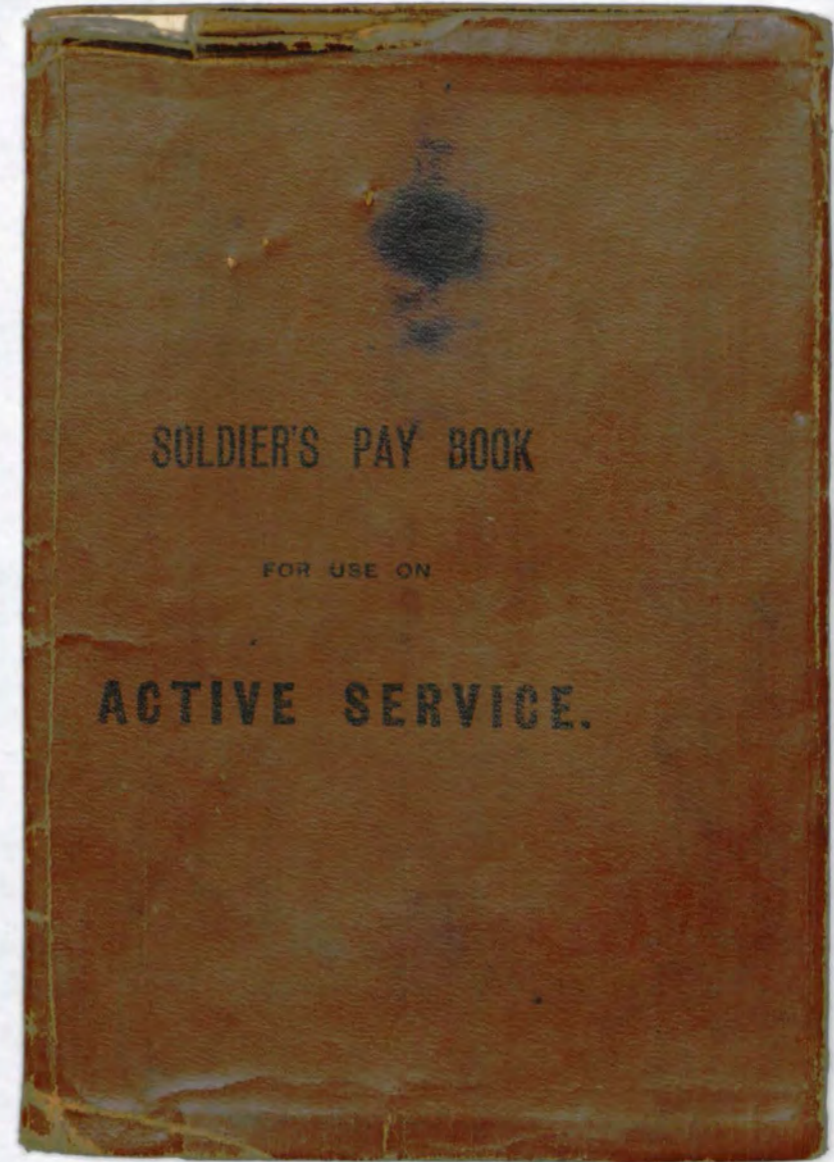

† If the Will is executed in Scotland by a Scotsman, the words "In the event, &c.," "and I give to" must be written by the man himself.
