- (1) *Yes I saw his will*
- (2) *beginning July 1916 when I was in*
- (3) *I leave all to my mother Mrs L Robinson 2 Carris St Belfast*
- (4) *It was written in pencil in his Army Pay book on page supplied for the purpose & I believe it was exactly a new book at that time he had a sum between £13 & 16 to his credit*
- (5) *Mr Jno Pellow 7 Manilla Terrace Skymount Avenue Belfast also had his book in his hand & read his will*
- (6) *His will was not then signed by any witnesses*

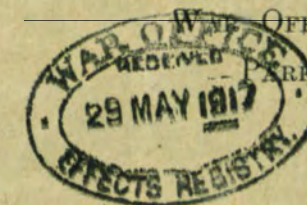

With reference to the estate of the late *Private G. Robinson*

1st Bn. Royal Inniskilling Fusiliers I am directed to acquaint you that it has been represented to this Department that you are aware of a will made by the deceased, and I am therefore to request that you will be good enough to furnish a statement showing:—

- (3) The exact words, as nearly as possible, and the date (if any), of the will.
- (4) Whether it was on a separate sheet, or whether it was in an Army Book. If in the latter, a short description of the book should be given.
- (5) The names and addresses of any persons, other than yourself, who saw and read the will.
- (6) The names and addresses of any witnesses who signed the will.

Your statement should be signed by you in the presence of a Magistrate or Minister, or other person holding a similarly responsible position and not interested in the matter, who should be asked to add his name, address, and qualification as witness, and to give a certificate showing that, in his opinion, full credit can be given to your statements in the matter.

- (6) The names and addresses of any witnesses who signed the will.
